





## DeCA- Ft Lee Commissary Supply Chain and Baby Formula Disruptions

- ✓ The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) is aggressively working to mitigate product delays and periods of product unavailability as a continued result of COVID-19's impacts leading to manufacturer cuts, ship delays, port congestion, labor, driver and raw material shortages that have all affected stock levels in our Distribution Centers.
- ✓ Commissaries nation-wide continue to experience baby formula shortages due to recalls and closure of the manufacturer plant that produces Similac, Alimentum and EleCare baby formula products. Recent flooding within the plant has caused further delays in manufacturing.
- ✓ Since May 13, in conjunction with established WIC (Women, Infants and Children) program purchasing limits at state levels, commissaries have placed product limitations on all classified specialty baby formula, similar to the limits customers are seeing in commercial retailers and military exchanges.
- ✓ Overseas WIC users are authorized to purchases quantities listed on WIC vouchers.
- ✓ DeCA remains committed to providing a world-class grocery benefit to our valued military communities and we appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to work through these trying and often uncertain times.





Back to School September 6, 2022



Students will be headed back to the classroom before we know it and keeping them safe is everyone's responsibility. Always **STOP** for school buses and remember these simple rules.

Yellow flashing lights on a school bus mean slow down — don't speed up — because the bus is preparing to stop. There are likely students waiting to get on the bus or parents waiting nearby to pick up children.

Red flashing lights mean stop and wait at least 20 feet behind the bus, children are getting on or off the school bus. Stay stopped until the red lights stop flashing, the extended stop-arm is withdrawn, and the bus begins moving. Even when lights aren't flashing, watch for children, particularly in the morning or midafternoon.

SLOW DOWN and be alert as you drive through a neighborhood, school zone or bus stop.

#### Teach our children to be SAFE!

Stay five steps away from the curb.

Always wait until the bus comes to a complete stop and the bus driver signals for you to board.

Face forward after finding a seat on the bus.

Exit the bus after it stops and look left-right-left for cars before crossing a street.

Turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances.

#### Halloween Fire Safety for Kids

If your children are going to Halloween parties at others' homes, have them look for ways out of the home and plan how they would get out in an emergency. If trick-or-treating, have them carry a flashlight or glow stick as part of their costume. Tell children to stay away from open flames such as candles and be sure they know how to stop, drop, and roll if their clothing catches fire.



#### Thanksgiving Fire Safety

Unattended cooking is the #1 leading factor in cooking fires. Thanksgiving is the peak day for home cooking fires with more than 3X the daily average for such incidents. Keep everyone safe and stay in the kitchen and focus on the food!




