- All symptomatic testing is arranged by primary care clinics, TMCs, PM or Occupational Health
- Pre-procedure testing is arranged by the primary care clinic or TMC
- Contact trace quarantine/testing is directed and arranged by PM
- SRC is responsible for requesting OCONUS testing for SMs and families
- Resource constraints continue to prevent support of at will testing or testing for leisure travel

- Establish an Allotment.** Starting January 1, 2021, TRICARE Select Group A Retirees have to pay enrollment fees.



Open Season: Nov. 9 - Dec. 14

Starting Jan. 1, 2021, TRICARE Select Group A retirees will have to pay a monthly enrollment fee.

- 💰 For an individual plan, you'll pay **\$12.50 per month**.
- 💰 For a family plan, you'll pay **\$25.00 per month**.

If you want to keep TRICARE Select coverage for you and your family, you must **take action**. If you don't act, **you'll be disenrolled from TRICARE Select**. Then, you'll only be able to get care from a military hospital or clinic.

You **must** take action and set up a monthly payment plan. Call your regional contractor before December 14, 2020. You may be required to pay 2-3 months of enrollment fees in advance.
