When: To start the October 18th drill @ 10:18, the Fort Lee Installation Operations Center (IOC) will send a test earthquake message through AtHoc that will trigger the drill.

Why: Earthquakes can occur whenever and wherever conditions are right, throughout the year. In an average year, 1,300,000 earthquakes occur worldwide of which 3,836 have occurred in the United States between 2000-2017 alone. In Virginia, the 2011, 5.8 magnitude earthquake and subsequent aftershocks as well as the 2014, 3.2 magnitude earthquakes demonstrate the need for preparing for such an event.

Supervision Levels	Definition	School Grade/Age Range
Direct supervision at all times	<p>Adult supervision on a regular basis during out of school hours during parental duty day.</p> <p>Child must be mature and competent in home alone skills and be able to contact a parent or designated adult in case of emergency.</p>	0 years to 5 th Grade
Monitored	An adult is aware of Child's location and activities during out of school hours. An emergency contact is available at all times.	<p>6th Grade (at least 11 years of old)</p> <p>2 consecutive hours</p>
Self-Care	Parents assess child's ability to be in self-care	<p>7th thru 8th Grade 4 consecutive hours</p> <p>9th thru 10th Grade 6 consecutive hours</p> <p>11 thru 12th Grade 10 consecutive hours (Ages 16-17)</p>
