When: To start the October 18th drill @ 10:18, the Fort Lee Installation Operations Center (IOC) will send a test earthquake message through AtHoc that will trigger the drill.

Why: Earthquakes can occur whenever and wherever conditions are right, throughout the year. In an average year, 1,300,000 earthquakes occur worldwide of which 3,836 have occurred in the United States between 2000-2017 alone. In Virginia, the 2011, 5.8 magnitude earthquake and subsequent aftershocks as well as the 2014, 3.2 magnitude earthquakes demonstrate the need for preparing for such an event.


