- **Duties and Responsibilities:**





The current TRICARE Retiree Dental Program will end **DEC. 31, 2018.**

Also, for the first time, most military retirees and their family members who are enrolled in a TRICARE health plan will have the option to enroll in vision benefits through FEDVIP.
