

*“Transition Kenner Army Health Clinic outpatient facility to an Active Duty only and Occupational Health clinic (AD/OH). Kenner AHC should maintain extended care hours to include weekend and holiday half-hours. All base support functions and pharmacy workload supporting all beneficiaries will be maintained.”*

*“It will take time for the supply and demand in a market to reach a balance, therefore transition MTF eligible to commercial providers may require two (2)-to-three (3) plus years to complete depending on local healthcare market conditions and number of enrollees dis-empaneled.”*

*Report to the Congressional Defense Committees, Section 703 NDAA 2017, 19 February 2020*

*Prime Beneficiaries within the 30 min service area of Fort Lee are not yet authorized to enroll outside of KAHC. NO CHANGE to care at this time.*
