

### **Hot Weather Care and Safety for Pets**

Fun in the sun with your pets? Here are some tips to keep your pets cool and safe all summer long



- Keep Them Cool
  - Avoid hot pavement
    - Grassy areas if possible
    - Check paw pads regularly
  - Limit exercise on hot days
    - Morning or evening are the best times for a walk
  - Ensure access to shade
  - Provide plenty of cool water







# The Community Action Council (CAC) Hot Weather Care and Safety for Pets

## Special Considerations

- Age and weight
  - Older and overweight animals are at an increased risk of overheating
  - Discuss with your veterinarian before implementing an exercise plan to aid weight loss in your pet
- Swimming
  - Not all dogs can swim! Consider doggie life jackets if out on the water
  - Exposure risk to blue-green algae, intestinal parasites, leptospirosis bacterium, and ticks





# The Community Action Council (CAC) Hot Weather Care and Safety for Pets

- Special Considerations
  - Health status
    - Pets with a chronic conditions, such as heart, kidney, or liver diseases, are less tolerant of heat and exercise
    - Heartworm positive pets are at an increased risk for overheating
  - Breed specific considerations
    - Breeds with thick coats: groom for shorter coat to reduce heat trapping
    - Breeds with thin coats and light skin: at risk for skin disease
    - Brachycephalic breeds (Pugs, Shih Tzus, Persians, etc.): less tolerant of heat and exercise than other breeds; HIGH RISK of overheating

# The Community Action Council (CAC) Hot Weather Care and Safety for Pets

- Heat Stroke
  - MEDICAL EMERGENCY!
  - Symptoms:
    - Heavy panting, glazed eyes, rapid heartbeat, difficulty breathing, excessive thirst, lethargy, fever, lack of coordination, profuse salivation, vomiting, deep red or purple tongue, seizures, unconsciousness, death
  - What do to:
    - Move to a cool, shaded area
    - Apply cool, wet towels to head, neck, and chest or run cool water over your pet
    - Let your pet lick ice or drink SMALL amounts of water
    - Take them to your vet IMMEDIATELY


